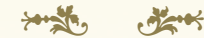
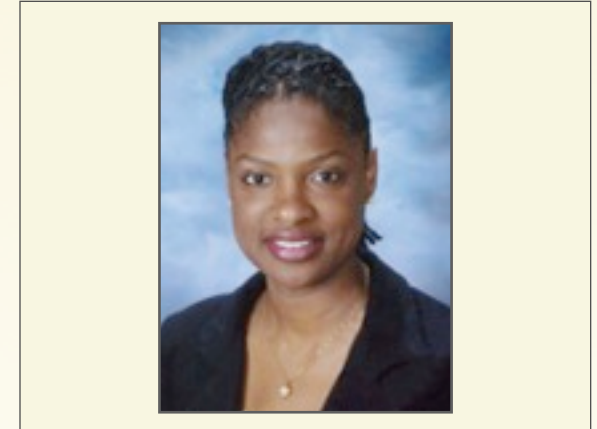


WHO IS MICHELLE

D. in Conflict Analysis and Resolution and a Master of Science in Dispute Resolution from Nova Southeastern University. Her Bachelor of Science in Social Work is from the University of the West Indies, St Augustine, Trinidad. She migrated to the United States in 1999 and lived in Florida until she moved to Massachusetts in 2004.

In addition she works as an independent consultant and does programming around issues related to peace building, violence prevention, race and ethnic relations and building social capital. She is the driving force behind Multicultural Village, and founded the organization primarily for teaching peace building both internationally and locally to youth 12-21 years, their parents, and college students through interactive workshops, service/volunteering and deep dialogue. She lives in Natick with her son.

FEES VARY BY ORGANIZATION OR AUDIENCE SIZE AND ARE NEGOTIABLE ON A CASE BY CASE BASIS.

Travel Expenses & Accommodations

Airfare, ground transportation, and hotel accommodations are required for all events. A per diem of \$100 per day will be required for programs over 3 hours.

Deposit & Cancellation Policy

Deposit

A deposit of 50% of the agreed fee is required upon confirmation of the booking and must be received within 10 days of the booking unless prior arrangements have been made. The remaining 50% of the agreed fee will be required 30 days prior to the event or upon speaker’s arrival if the event is within 30 days of booking.

Cancellation

In event of program cancellation, Multicultural Village Inc. will re-book the program on a mutually convenient date with no penalty if the program is rescheduled within six months. Any deposits paid at the time of cancellation shall be credited to rebooked event. If the program is cancelled and not rescheduled, the initial deposit will be considered full and complete payment. If the speaker attends the event and does not speak due to event schedule conflicts then full payment will be required.

We know how stressful it can be to create, organize, and put on an event. We also know how crucial it is to secure a speaker who will deliver. Once you decide you’re ready to book Dr. Cromwell, we use a simple process that includes (1) event questionnaire, (2) choosing presentation topic, (3) confirming the booking, and (4) contract execution and remittance of deposit.
